APPENDIX: CLANCY TRANSCRIPT (PART1)

TRANSCRIBED OCT. 20, 2015

RYAN CLANCY:

I saw what happened to you while you were there, which sucks and I'm sorry that that happened. Uhh- but I wanted to call you because I know you were calling some of the folks at No Labels, and I just wanted to see, you know — what we can do for you, or what you want to talk about. I'm actually the Communications Director for No Labels, so I was there at the event.

ROD WEBBER:

It's only Sam Boswell that I've been communicating with .

RYAN CLANCY:

Okay.

ROD WEBBER:

And he was the only contact that I could really get a hold of — I think I tried to tweet to the main account, but I didn't get any response from that.

RYAN CLANCY:

Okay

ROD WEBBER:

Basically, my main concern is identifying the Trump staff member [Deck] who was involved in throwing me over the table there. As Sam [Boswell] told me, — and what I assumed when I got there is you have your own security, and Trump staff doesn't have security. And so I was basically standing my ground. I really just wanted to— I had a nice spot in the front row. I just wanted to go back to the front row— and obviously, they didn't want that. And I stood my ground, and he's— as far as I know, a private citizen who basically grabbed me by the arm, assisted by the police, without any warning by the police, threw me around over a table to the ground. So they essentially assaulted me. They detained me, then they released me. And then while I was quietly sitting on a park bench later, they came over— the police came over and arrested me. Basically they were waiting for the media to leave.

RYAN CLANCY:

Right.

ROD WEBBER:

So from my standpoint, this is very unfortunate on a number of levels. Not just on the physical and emotional level, but now this is a massive legal problem for me. I'm heading into Manchester now to try to speak to the police. This is going to be an ongoing battle. And as we know from the Efrain Galicia event, which was the Mexican protester who was assaulted by Trump staff at Trump tower, and all the people who were assaulted in Virginia by Trump staff, Donald Trump is suing all of them. So I can expect as soon as I name this guy, I can assume I

will be sued as well. That said, I want to carry through with justice, and as the name of your event would imply— “Problem Solvers,” it’s clearly a problem that clearly needs to be solved.

RYAN CLANCY:

Yeah. Ya know **Rod. I’m really sorry all this has happened to you. And it isn’t right.**

ROD WEBBER:

Thanks

RYAN CLANCY:

And I mean that. It’s just ah— this is—umm— the way you got treated is— I don’t know is , is for the [unintelligible] for the way that — not even protesters— but just regular people coming to these

ROD WEBBER:

And **I’m not a protester**— I’m well known for—

RYAN CLANCY:

I know — you were just there— standing your— I know that. Yeah. So. But Rod, here’s the problem though. In terms of what we’re able to do. Is The way the event worked that day. Is, we had it— it was our event— We were hosting it. And we had security. **But the security we had was just four off-duty Manchester Police Officers. So, that was the No Labels affiliated security.**

ROD WEBBER:

You mean they were hired staff security, is what you're saying?

RYAN CLANCY:

Yes. That's correct. So there's just four of these guys, ya know— they were at the exits at certain strategic spots. But, each campaign also had their own security details. Some bigger than others, and some pretty big. Trump, ya know, was the biggest.

ROD WEBBER:

Sure.

RYAN CLANCY:

And so, the thing is, part of the conditions for a lot of these candidates participating in these events is they — you can say to them hey, you know look, we have our own security , but they're like, well, yeah, we're bringing our own security too, we trust our people.

ROD WEBBER:

And of course, that makes sense. I think. **But that doesn't make them above the law.**

RYAN CLANCY:

Of course, no— Of course not! But the thing is, Rod, is, we, I don't, I am more— we. We don't have any more information than you do.
